Pray with Luther and the other Reformers and hear what they have to teach us about prayer.

Lamentations

(March 5-April 2)

Laments are prayers of grief, of loss, of mourning and sorrow. Hear the laments of ancient Israel, and learn how they can help us pray our own grief and sorrow today.

Prayers of the Global Church

(April 23-May 7)

Pray with the saints around the world and make their prayers your own.

(May 14-21)
